This contest is designed to showcase students' love for the environment and their favorite aspects of living in the Lowcountry while also allowing them to express their creativity and environmental awareness through art.

### Guidelines:

**The contest is open to all elementary and middle school students.**

**Themes:** Your design should feature creatures from the Lowcountry or the salt marsh environment. Examples include crabs, pelicans, dolphins, marsh grass, oysters, etc.

**Artwork Types:** Acceptable formats include paintings, drawings, or original digital artwork. For examples of artwork, please see page three of this document.

**Size:** Designs should be suitable for turning into a temporary tattoo. Keep your artwork clear and simple enough to be recognizable at a small size. Background illustrations should be minimal. *Note: We may alter images slightly to ensure a high-quality tattoo design.*

### Submission & Deadline:

Designs must be submitted by June 14, 2024. Please submit a high-quality scan of your artwork (300 dpi or larger) by filling out the attached submission form on [outsidefoundation.org/tattoo](https://outsidefoundation.org/tattoo).

### Winners:

Winners will be announced by June 30, 2024. Winning designs will be digitized and produced as temporary tattoos to be distributed during the Keep the Broad Creek Clean Festival. Winners will also receive special recognition at the event and a prize from The Outside Foundation.
